

Challenges

This hands-free solution streamlines workflows, enhances operator comfort, and is now fully integrated across inbound, outbound, and picking processes. To further increase efficiency and ensure scalability, Digitec expanded its deployment with additional ProGlove technologies:

- Reels enabling ergonomic and flexible scanning across multiple angles
- Gateway Plus ensuring reliable and high-performance 5 GHz Wi-Fi connectivity
- More than 350 devices deployed to support business growth and peak demand
